

## Ecology and Evolutionary Biology Minor – Plan of Study

**Instructions to students:** The EEB Minor requires at least 15 credits of 2000-level or above Ecology and Evolutionary Biology (EEB) courses, which must include both EEB 2244 or 2244W and EEB 2245 or 2245W. Only courses that you earn a C or better in can be used towards the minor. Substitutions are not allowed.

Most EEB courses require BIOL 1107 and 1108 (or equivalent) as prerequisites, but these do not count towards the minor. You may take more than 15 credits of EEB courses, and we encourage you to do so.

When you are preparing your final plan of study, you must obtain department approval that you have satisfied the requirements for the Ecology & Evolutionary Biology minor. Contact an advisor in the Biology Advising Center (Biology/Physics Building Room 101) for a signature on this form. Then submit the signed form to the Registrar's Office.
